New Life Christian Church New Member Class Outline

#### **Class Duration** - 90 Minutes

**Objective** - Equip new members with the vision, mission, and practical steps to get connected and grow in faith at New Life Christian Church.

## 1. Welcome & Icebreaker (10 Minutes)

- Brief introduction by the pastor or facilitator.
- Icebreaker Question "What drew you to New Life Christian Church?" (Allow a few to share to foster a sense of community.)

## 2. Our Story - Who We Are (15 Minutes)

- Mission and Vision
  - o *Mission* The mission of New Life Christian Church is to love God, to love others, and to magnify the name of Jesus Christ.
  - o *Vision* The vision of our church is to attend to the spiritual, social, and physical needs of the members and the community, to develop ministry gifts for service to the community and the world, and to build strong families by raising up strong men.
- **Brief History** Share a short narrative of New Life Christian Church's journey and key milestones.
- **Core Values** Explain the values of faith, community, service, and growth in action.

# 3. What We Believe - Core Beliefs (15 Minutes)

- Share the church's foundational beliefs, such as
  - o The Bible as God's Word.
  - o Salvation through Jesus Christ.
  - o The importance of baptism and communion.

• Present this in a conversational, relatable manner—focus on essentials rather than dense doctrine.

## 4. Connecting & Growing - What's Next? (20 Minutes)

## • Opportunities to Connect -

- o Small Groups Explain their purpose and invite attendees to join one.
- o Events and Fellowship Highlight upcoming gatherings.

## • Opportunities to Grow -

- o Bible Studies Share times and topics for study groups.
- o Prayer Meetings Invite participation and share prayer resources.

## • Opportunities to Serve -

- o Ministries Overview Briefly discuss options such as children's ministry, hospitality, or community outreach.
- o Highlight the importance of serving according to spiritual gifts.

# 5. Spiritual Gifts Exercise (15 Minutes)

- Introduce the concept of spiritual gifts with a brief explanation.
- Distribute a short, interactive spiritual gifts assessment (or QR code for an online version).
- Discuss next steps for discovering how their gifts align with ministry opportunities.

## 6. Expectations & Commitment (10 Minutes)

- Outline the commitments of church membership
  - o Regular attendance at worship services.
  - o Growing in faith through personal devotion and community study.
  - o Supporting the church financially and through service.
- Reaffirm the church's commitment to support their spiritual growth and journey.

## 7. Closing & Next Steps (5 Minutes)

- Next Steps
  - o Ensure they've completed the membership form if they haven't already.
  - o Share details about any upcoming new member events or orientations.
- **Closing Prayer** Pray over the new members, their growth, and their connection to the church family.

## **Key Features for Engagement -**

- Use visuals Create a slide deck or printed handouts with the mission, vision, and core beliefs.
- Keep it interactive Include group discussion, Q&A, and activities like the spiritual gifts exercise.
- Respect time Stick to the schedule to build trust and enthusiasm for future participation.
